

# Why can't I download my favorite author's titles from OverDrive?

It's probably because of the publisher's stance toward eBooks in libraries via OverDrive (the leading library eBook vendor).  
Of the six largest publishers, only Random House offers eBooks to libraries without restriction via OverDrive.

Recently stopped making eBooks available to libraries, and previously purchased eBooks must be transferred via USB, rather than delivered wirelessly.	Cooperates fully with libraries, but is instituting high licensing fees in 2012.  As of 3/01/12, Random House has doubled and in some cases, tripled their prices for eBooks.
